# Small Group Game or Activity

1What you need: Muslin Doll

1. Show kids the doll.

Say: Let's pretend this doll is our neighbor. They need help! They're sick, hungry, cold, hurt, and need a friend to talk to. Let's say today's Point together to remind us what to do.

- 2. Say the point together: Good neighbors care, share, and they're always there.
- 3. Give each kid a label marked with a HEART from the first column of the bandage labels sheet. If you have extra labels, give kids more than one.
- 4. Kids pass the doll around to stick the bandages onto the doll to spell out the point.
- 5. Remove labels from the doll, and repeat the game with the labels marked with a DIAMOND from the second column of the bandage labels sheet, but time kids with a smart phone or by counting.
- 6. If time allows, repeat the game with labels marked with a SHAMROCK from the third column. Challenge kids to beat their previous time

#### **Small Group Discussion**

Review the Point and Bible Verse

Point:Good neighbors care, share, and they're always there.

Verse: Luke 10:27 NLT ... "'You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind.' And, 'Love your neighbor as yourself."

- Name as many people as you can think of. They're all your neighbors!
- What do you think it takes to be a good neighbor?
- Share a time someone was a good neighbor to you. How can you be a good neighbor if a kid acts mean?

If you need to fill time: Do the small group activity again or play a different game like Simon Says or 20 Questions, Charades, Duck, Duck, Goose, Telephone, Honey If You Love Me, Rock, Paper, Scissors, I Spy, or Thumb Wars
