Keep It Simple: Baptism

Ice Breaker:

Tell the group about a time you didn't want to start something. Did that turn out to be a good or a bad thing?

Scripture:

Read Romans 6:1-11

Questions:

Why is it so difficult to look past our imperfections and see the beauty God created in us?

Baptism is not the finish line, it is the starting line in our relationship with God. Many times this comes with lots of questions. What are some of your questions that you wrestle with when starting or continuing this journey?

Based on Romans 6 what happens when we are baptized? How does knowing that change or add to your understanding of the importance of baptism?

What is the sin that you need to be freed from or have been freed from in Christ? How has being freed from that sin united you with Christ?

Application:

If you haven't been baptized what is holding you back from baptism? Who can you talk to about what is holding you back?

If you have been baptized, how do you remember your baptism and take a next step in your relationship with God?
