This report celebrates and shares our collective gratitude to the Lord for His work in 2024. It is with great joy that we recount the incredible things God has done through The Village Christian Church.

Our Online Campus reached a record 657 people per week through YouTube, Facebook, and The Village Live. This 24/7 digital ministry continues to connect with people across the globe, leading many to then engage with our physical campuses.

At our Seneca campus, we weathered the challenge of a flooded basement in the spring, but emerged with a beautifully restored and expanded Kids Ministry space. Patrick Ugolini's leadership as Community Pastor has been a true blessing. Seneca plans to add a second Sunday service in 2025 to accommodate continued growth, and will celebrate 4 years of ministry in February.

The Coal City campus celebrated 2 years of ministry in December 2024, now reaching over 200 people per week. This fast-growing community is expanding its facilities by 3,400 square feet, creating space to welcome up to 500 people weekly.

Our newest campus, Shorewood, launched on November 3rd with 215 people in its inaugural service. This campus, operating out of Trinity Christian School, is poised for incredible opportunities to reach more of the Shorewood community.

Even as the Minooka campus sent 100 people to support the new Shorewood location, God has already replenished those ranks. Minooka celebrated 20 years of ministry in October and will add a third Sunday service in late January 2025.

In the pages that follow, you will read stories of lives transformed by the power of God. Every number represents a person, every name a story, and every story matters deeply to our Lord.

We are humbled and grateful for God's provision in His Church!

At the Village, we believe in equipping our people from within to lead. It's been a year of creating team structures, refining our processes and team building in every ministry. In spring of 2024, Nick Sandeno stepped into his role as Minooka Community Pastor. Recognizing an opportunity to bring greater cohesion to our ministries, he spearheaded the creation of Central Services—a central group that helps bring cohesion to our core ministry functions.

The Central Service team consists of communications, worship, children's and student ministries. This dedicated group serves as a vital resource hub, providing support, guidance, and unified direction to our Seneca, Coal City, and Shorewood campuses. Through their work, we're ensuring consistent, high-quality ministry experience while empowering each location with the tools and coaching they need to thrive.

In the middle of our organizational changes, we witnessed God's faithfulness in remarkable ways.



This fall, 100 people were set to start our Shorewood campus and we watched in awe as God brought more than 80 new faces through our doors within weeks. Our services are now FULL—a testament to God's provision! We're deeply grateful for the dedication of our team members and coaches who have embraced new service roles, making this transition both smooth and successful.

What a year it's been at our Seneca campus! Sure, we hit a bump in the road when some plumbing problems flooded the Kid Village basement this spring, but that didn't slow us down one bit. Pastor Patrick and his amazing team rolled up their sleeves, putting in countless hours to fix up, paint, and rebuild the space - all while keeping our Seneca community going strong.

The Kid Village team got super creative during that time and turned the great outdoors into an awesome classroom experience. Over the year, Pulse Students at West Campus experienced record attendance and those monthly after-service brunches turned into the perfect chance for everyone to hang out and have a blast. Looking back, what started as a challenging year ended up being way better than anyone expected! Thank you God!



- We partnered with the Seneca Park District to serve treats at numerous events in town. At Christmas at Crotty Park, Pulse students and leaders served hot chocolate and cookies to hundreds in attendance.
- One of our favorite, and most well attended Sundays, was Mother's Day service at Graves Park. It was the most beautiful day and we loved celebrating our moms and special women in our lives!
- Our Pulse Students Thanksgiving was the most well attended kids and students events of the year! Over 98 students came to eat turkey and all the fixings at West Campus in November!



- Through Reclaimed, we were able to give away and deliver 45 Thanksgiving meal boxes to families in need.
- Over 20 people signed up to serve as teammates after After a message, 4 people responded publicly our "Everybody Serves" message during the "I Love My Church" series.
- · A Dream Team was created to think of creative ways to bring and contine to lead people to Jesus!

What a year it's been in Coal City! God's perfect timing never fails. As more people have found their way to our Coal City campus, we've watched our services fill to capacity - even running out of seats on November 17th! But God was already ahead of us. Pastor Mike and a group of teammates had already begun construction expanding across the hall. This new space will welcome 80+ more people and double our Kid Village area. We can't wait to see how God uses this expanded space when we open in January 2025!

As we look back at 2024, we're in awe of how God moved - from making connections in the Shorewood community, to hosting unforgettable events, to our team coming together like family, all leading up to our incredible Grand Opening on November 3rd where we welcomed record numbers! But this is just the beginning - we can't wait to see how God uses this campus to transform lives in Shorewood in 2025!


- · We connected with our community at Crossroads Fest in Shorewood, introducing our new church, meeting neighbors, and building relationships while handing out freebies





Now I just want to work to grow His Kingdom and share the LOVE of Jesus Christ with anyone who will listen.





Reclaim3d, the charity arm of The Village Christian Church, exists to reclaim bad circumstances into something beautiful locally, regionally, and globally. Founded in 2016, Reclaim3d is a non-profit that helps people in need and provides hope in a world that's sometimes hard to handle.

LOCAL

- We provided 20 mobile food distributions (10,000 pounds of food per event) for local communities. Each mobile food pantry served approximately 100 families!
- The Big Give for Kids served 450 local kids with a free pair of brand new shoes, 2-3 bags of gently used school clothes and an enormous amount of school supplies to start the year!
- We ensured no child went home hungry through our weekend backpack program, which supported over 100 students in the Minooka/Channahon school system throughout the school year.
- Our benevolence program stood by ready to help community members with essential needs, including counseling services, utility assistance, vehicle repairs, and emergency support, when personal crisis arose.



- 1700 families served during mobile food pantries
- 70 families served Thanksgiving dinner in holiday boxes
- 44 families served with Christmas presents (107 kids)
- 200 families served by Miss Pearl's Christmas store
- 150 families served at Dance The Night Away
- 100 families served through utility assistance
- 200 families served at The Big Give For Kids
- Countless others in Haiti from the 100,000 Lifeline meal pack

REGIONAL & GLOBAL

- We treated 160 special needs guests to a prom-like atmosphere called "Dance the Night Away" this
 past spring.
- We partnered with Ms. Pearl's Daycare in Chicago's Roseland community, which provides free
 childcare to single mothers pursuing education or employment. Her organization operates entirely on
 donations. We supported her vital ministry through our annual Christmas store and year-round
 initiatives to help families build paths toward self-sufficiency.
- We hosted and completed the Lifeline Mission 100,000 meal pack in November
- We provided support to Heart for Africa by selling ornaments. The sale of ornaments helps to support orphans in Eswatini, Africa.
- We financially assisted Destiny Rescue, an organization that rescues and restores 3,000 plus kids from human trafficking.







In November of 2024 we embarked on a 2 year journey called "Unfinished." We believe we are an unfinished people with an unfinished story and God has some great things in store for us as a church in the future.

The Vision for Unfinished (November 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026) is as follows:

- 1. Reach 2,000 more people for Christ
- 2. Give away \$250,000 to needs outside our church wall
- 3. Pay down \$750,000 in debt

Our goal is 100% participation in this vision by everyone who calls The Village Christian Church their home. We don't want you to miss out on the opportunity to share God's love with your neighbors and your friends and your family!

As we enter into 2025, we have set our budgets to reach 2,000 more, give away to needs outside our walls and pay down debt. We ask that everyone takes time to pray through what God is calling you to do financially in support of this Vision.
